

COMMUNICATIONS VIA Groups.10

The Boosters main form of communication with you will be via group e-mail. The Directors will use Charms to send any information needed to share regarding itineraries, trips, concerts, etc. The Boosters use Groups.io for updates on fundraising, events, volunteer needs, etc.

Our booster e-mail group is *essential* for any parent who has a child in the band. Without being a member of the group, you cannot receive fundraising information, requests for volunteering and more. All booster business for the band is done via this group. **You must send a request to be added to the group.**

All E-mails come into your inbox with the beginning of the subject line: **[gchsbands]** so it is easy for you to filter and search on messages.

Send a request from your e-mail address at which you wish to receive your messages to: gchsbands+subscribe@groups.io Do not type a message or a subject just simply send the e-mail.

- Once you send the e-mail you will receive an e-mail back from groups.io. If you do not receive an e-mail quickly check your spam or junk mailbox. The e-mail will request that you confirm that you wanted to subscribe by replying. (no need to comment again)
- Next you will receive two e-mails. One inviting you to groups.io and another telling you your subscription is pending.
- o This second e-mail you will respond to and let us know your relationship with the band.
- At this point your request will be sent to the group moderator for approval.
- Once you are approved you will receive an approval e-mail and a welcome e-mail.

How to Unsubscribe from the Booster E-mail Group

It is pretty simple. Send an e-mail to: gchsbands+unsubscribe@groups.io You should receive an e-mail stating you are removed. If you have any trouble unsubscribing, write to website@gchsbands.org and we can help you.

PRACTICE ATTIRE

Band members should wear comfortable clothing. White socks and tennis shoes are *required*. (No sandals or flip flops). The school dress code applies during all rehearsals (Pre-Band Camp, Band Camp and Post-Band Camp Rehearsals). NO loose tank tops, spaghetti strap shirts, bathing suit tops, or short length shorts.

UNIFORMS

Here is a list of items that each new band student will need to purchase from the boosters during Rookie Days Camp and will be able to use for the duration of their time in band. *Please note that costs may change slightly each year*.

WIND INSTRUMENT STUDENTS Total costs = ~\$106 and includes:

- Summer Uniform shirt (\$22)
- White Marching Shoes (\$38)
- Marching Uniform Gloves (\$4)
- Marching Uniform Suspenders (\$7)
- Marching Uniform Shoulder Cords (\$26)
- Poncho (\$9)

PERCUSSION STUDENTS Total costs = ~\$76 and includes:

- Summer Uniform Shirt (\$22)
- White Marching Shoes (\$38)
- Marching Uniform Suspenders (\$7)
- Poncho (\$9)
- ✓ *Percussion marching uniforms do not require Gloves or Cords

GUARD MEMBERS Total costs = ~\$31 and includes

- Summer Uniform Shirt (\$22)
- Poncho (\$9)
- Other supplies as needed (cost varies year to year)

Freshman and NEW band members will be fitted for shoes and be able to purchase the above items during Rookie Camp (see band calendar, Rookie Camp is Thursday and Friday the first week after school is out). Please send a blank check or cash with your child on the day of their uniform fitting. Items will not be ordered and/or issued until the money is received. The shoes will be used for both summer and marching uniforms.

FALL MARCHING UNIFORMS

ALL Band members will be fitted for uniforms in August during Pre-Band Camp. Please be sure to wear lightweight summer shorts for the fittings. The dates are posted to the band calendar. **The yearly fall uniform fee for 2023-2024 is \$125.00.** This fee must be paid by the July 31 "BIG" Booster meeting at Grove City Church of the Nazarene. <u>This fee will be on your Charms account and can be paid online at any time prior to the meeting in July.</u>

The following items are provided/maintained by the Band Boosters and are included in your annual uniform fee: Jackets (Old/Football & New/Contest), Football uniform, Contest Uniform Football Uniform Overlay, Hat, Plume, Hat Bag and Garment Bag.

The items purchased at Rookie Days (**Shoes, Gloves, Cords, Suspenders and Poncho**) will complete your Marching Uniforms (see estimates on previous page).
